The Guide-in-Training program teaches Native teens skills needed for employment in natural resources, tourism, and wilderness medicine.

CFI trains participants in hiking, canyoneering, and river guiding. We visit cultural heritage sites and utilize Native expertise to explore naturalist interpretation, archaeology, herbalism, and Native ways of understanding.

We welcome youth and professionals from any tribe to collaborate.
